Dear North Huntingdon Resident,

We are excited to inform you that County Hauling, operating as a division of the Westmoreland Sanitary Landfill, was awarded the four-year contract to be the Waste and Recycling Hauler for the Township of North Huntingdon, starting January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. We look forward to providing North Huntingdon with a safe and efficient collection program for your Garbage, Recycling, Yard Waste, E-Waste and Household Hazardous Waste.

Our contract is similar to the one that the Township had with your previous hauler, but one thing that may be changing is the day your trash and recycling is collected.

**All collection pickup days will be delayed by one day if one of the holidays listed below falls on a weekday PRECEDING your collection day**

New Years Day | Memorial Day | Independence Day | Labor Day | Thanksgiving Day | Christmas Day

**The following guidelines apply to waste and recycling collection:**

- Garbage and recycling cans, bags and bulk items must be placed at the curb the night before your collection day, or prior to 6 AM on the day of collection
- Recycling must be placed in the designated blue recycling bins (see reverse of this page for a list of recyclable and non-recyclable materials)
- Bulk item disposal (refrigerators with the freon removed, stoves, beds, mattresses, couches etc.) is **limited to one item per week**. Residents may arrange for collection of multiple items, but must call Customer Service first; additional charges may apply
- In circumstances where the quantity of solid waste makes regular collection impractical, please call customer service. This is a rare occurrence, mostly related to move-outs or estate clean-outs
- There will be six collections of Yard Waste per year, see enclosed schedule for dates. All Yard Waste must be in biodegradable bags and placed at the curb
- Grass is considered solid waste and may be placed at the curb for regular trash collection
- See the enclosed E-Waste and Household Hazardous Waste flyer for directions on how to request door-side collection service

If you have any questions about the list of recyclable and non-recyclable materials below, please call Customer Service.

**Glass** is now categorized as **NON-RECYCLABLE**, as are **Types 3-7 Plastics**. There is no market to sell the recycling into so it is going to the landfill by way of the recycling center, creating a greater environmental impact than it would if placed directly in the trash.

The two types of plastic that are still recyclable are **Types 1 & 2**, which are among the most common. Examples of Type 1 are soda bottles, water bottles, salad dressing bottles and cooking oil bottles (bottles you drink from or that hold consumables). Some examples of Type 2 are milk and juice jugs, shampoo, conditioner or bodywash bottles and laundry detergents containers. Neither of these lists are comprehensive, so be sure to check each container for the recycling logo and the codes PET or PETE for Type 1 and PEHD or HDPE for Type 2. If the container has any of these codes, it is recyclable. If they have a different code, please put it in the trash.

- Boxboard: such as tissue, dryfood boxes, cereal, noodles and cake boxes.
- Magazines and Catalogs

**The following rates apply for the year 2020 and are inclusive of all services (Trash, Recycling, Yard Waste, E-Waste & HHW)**

- Regular Rate – \$49.62/quarter
- Senior Rate - \$46.95/quarter
- Door Side Pick Up –\$22/month **in addition to** the Regular Rate or the Senior Rate for anyone requesting Door Side Pickup without a valid medical waiver
- Senior Per Bag Sticker Rate – \$1.79/bag with a minimum yearly order of 24 stickers. Total price for 24 stickers (1 year if no additional stickers are purchased) is \$42.96.
  - If you were on the senior sticker list with Waste Management, you will be receiving an invoice for \$42.96, with the stickers following in the mail shortly after. You can purchase additional stickers by calling Customer Service at 724-929-7694 Ext. 2, by emailing Customer Service at info@countyhauling.com or by stopping by the Township office at 11279 Center Highway (sticker purchase from the Township will be strictly cash or check)
  - **The stickers from Waste Management do not carry over. You will need to purchase new stickers from County Hauling.**

Invoices for the Senior Stickers will be sent prior to January 1<sup>st</sup>. Regular quarterly bills will be sent in mid-February for all other services.
